

The Department of Workforce Services, Business Training and Support Unit offers a variety of grants that Wyoming based businesses can access to increase the skills of their current workforce. Among the different grant options, Apprenticeship Grants are available through both the Apprenticeship State Expansion Grant (ASE) program and the Workforce Development Training Fund (WDTF) program while the Internship Grant option is available through WDTF.

What is an Internship and how can the Internship grant help your business?

An internship is a short-term, structured, practical learning experience that will enhance an individual's work skills, knowledge, and abilities. An internship offers an opportunity to observe, contribute, and rotate through the different parts of an organization while determining if that career field is of interest.

Through the WDTF Internship Grant, Wyoming businesses can be reimbursed for intern wages up to \$12/hr for up to 1040 hours /state fiscal year.

What is an Apprenticeship and how can the Apprenticeship grants help your business?

An apprenticeship is a real job with a structured learning component, so a registered apprentice can earn a wage while they learn and become fully trained in a chosen occupation. Through the apprenticeship grants, businesses are able to be reimbursed for each apprentice and costs associated with on the job training (OJT). Businesses may also receive reimbursement associated with the apprenticeship program's related instruction component including; registration fees, books, travel expenses directly related to the related instruction, instructor fees, and other eligible expenses.
